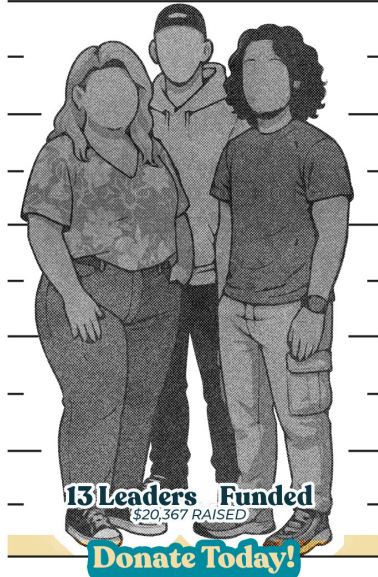

MULTIPLYING IMPACT:
7 YEARS OF PROVEN YOUTH MINISTRY WITH JOSE & MAYRA CAMPOS
From 1 Leader to 6, From 1 Student to 42: Real Proof & Impact in Youth Ministry



When Jose Campos’s childhood home burned down during his senior year of high school, he hit rock bottom. The answer to his desperate prayer came through a Christian family who opened their home, and a prophecy that would chart his life’s course: “Everything you will go through will help you become a pastor.”

Today, Jose and his wife Mayra serve 42 students weekly at Huntington Assembly of God in Long Island, New York—30 students every Friday through Forward Youth, plus 12 additional students through their Thursday after-school program, The Station.

THE LONG ROAD BACK

The pandemic nearly destroyed what they’d built. Before COVID-19, Forward Youth thrived with 40 students. When they returned to in-person ministry at the end of 2020, only one student showed up.

“It was heartbreaking,” Jose recalls. But the Lord told them clearly: Keep going.

One student became five. Five became ten. Today, they’re back to 30-40 students. For the first 5.5 years, Jose and Mayra carried this ministry largely alone. Now their team has grown to six leaders.

THE FOUNDATION THAT CHANGED EVERYTHING

Jose’s journey with Urban Youth Workers Institute began with the UYWI Certification Program. But it was UYWI’s Whole Life Discipleship (WLD) program that revolutionized their ministry.

“WLD helped us create a programming calendar that completely reshaped everything.”

“WLD helped us create a programming calendar that completely reshaped everything,” Jose explains. “Instead of doing the same thing every Friday, we learned to intertwine community partners, connect with parents, and touch all holistic areas. Now we have small groups,

hangout time, sports—we’re reaching students in every area of life.”

This year has brought something unprecedented: a spontaneous surge of spiritual hunger. “There’s been a big boom of hunger for Christ,” Jose says. Students who previously avoided church now attend Friday nights and Sunday services. They’re reading Scripture on their own, displaying genuine spiritual growth.

“It’s beautiful,” Jose says. “Now we’re launching them out.”
